This year, Coombe Road has £50,000 less than we had last year. Out of this budget, we still need to pay the amazing staff, run our very old premises, pay bills and provide resources for our children, as well as all the other services needed for schools. We thank you for your support when we have no other option but to ask you for contributions, particularly for educational visits. We are working so hard to ensure that our budget does not impact on our children.

Collectively our children receive £48,133,230 less per year towards their education than if our per-pupil funding were equal to that of schools in Westminster. We don't think this is fair so today, as part of the 'Worth Less?' Campaign, we have submitted an invoice to the Treasury for this shortfall.
