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Year 2 also had a stress-free 'Biscuit Week' which was organised by the amazing team in KS1 to ensure testing is carried out calmly and without anxiety.


Results will be published on the Endof_Year Reports in July.




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Excellence

Apollo realised that they couldn't ever be friends. He sadly said goodbye to the coyote and thought about what to do next.






