COVID SECURE ROUTINES:

Covid-19 is sticking around and so it is highly likely that our new procedures for drop-off and pick-up



will not be changing any time soon. Thank you so much for following guidelines to keep everybody safe and ensure that our school stays open.

We do understand that the routines are not ideal and would love to go back to our old systems – but this is just not possible in the middle of a pandemic. We have strict guidelines to follow and we must do so in order to keep everybody safe and reduce the risk of infection.

Classteachers will do their best to get to you earlier on a rainy day but this is not always possible due to the nature of other responsibilities they have in the mornings, and especially if there is another class with an earlier entry time at the same gate.

This new routine at drop-off and pick-up is likely to

go on until at least the spring term in 2021, so please ensure that your child has a suitable rain coat for rainy days to keep them dry and warm. Unfortunately, the bad weather and pandemic are completely out of our control.

Again, thank you for doing your bit and keeping everybody as safe as possible by following guidance.

RUMOURS AND HEATING:

It never ceases to amaze me the rumours that are sent around our community sometimes. I was informed this morning of parents/carers being told that we are "not allowed to put the heating on for 3 weeks".

This is absolutely not true – and we will put the heating on as soon as it is necessary.

At the moment, we have some windows and doors open for ventilation. This is to reduce the risk of infection from Covid-19 which can hang

around in poorly ventilated rooms for some time. With up to 30 children and their body heat in a class room, it is not cold in classes at the moment.

It is really not in any of our nature to let our children sit freezing in classrooms – something I would hope that our community are aware of already.

Please do not listen to gossip and trust that we are keeping your children as safe and warm as we possibly can, whilst also following guidelines to reduce the risk of infection.
