
We will review this after half term if necessary.

ABSENCE FROM SCHOOL:

Please call us if your child is unable to attend school. It is really important that you also give us the reason for the absence. If your child has any of the following symptoms, the household must self-isolate for 14 days (I have attached the guidance for your information):

- High temperature/fever (38°C or more) Persistent, new cough •

my child has COVID-19 symptoms	 Do not come into school Contact school to inform us Self-isolate the whole household 	the test comes back negative OR 10 days have passed since the first day of symptoms and your child feels well
my child tests positive for COVID-19	 Do not come into school Contact school to inform us Agree an earliest date for possible return (min. 10 days) Self-isolate the whole household (including siblings) for 14 days 	they feel better. They can return to school after 10 days even if they have a cough or loss of taste/smell. These symptoms can last for several weeks
my child tests negative	 Contact school to inform us Discuss when your child can come back 	your child feels well enough to return
my child is ill with symptoms that are not linked to COVID-19	 Do not come into school Contact school to inform us Check temperature (should not be 37.8°C or more) Ring on each day of illness 	as per attendance policy or advice from your GP/111 and as long as they are showing no symptoms of COVID-19
somebody in my household has COVID-19 symptoms	 Do not come into school Contact school to inform us Self-isolate the whole household (14 days) Symptomatic household member to get a COVID-19 test Inform the school of the test result 	the test comes back negative and no other member of the household has developed symptoms
somebody in my household tests positive for COVID-19	 Do not come into school Contact school to inform us Agree an earliest date for possible return (min. 14 days) Self-isolate the whole household 	the child has completed a minimum of 14 days isolation and has not developed any symptoms
NHS test and trace has identified my child as a close contact of somebody with symptoms or confirmed COVID-19	 Do not come into school Contact school to inform us Agree an earliest date for possible return (min. 14 days) 	the child has completed a minimum of 14 days isolation and has not developed any symptoms
NHS test and trace has identified a household member (not my child) as a close contact of somebody with symptoms or confirmed COVID-19	 The household member contacted must self-isolate for 14 days If the person contacted through NHS test and trace does not have any symptoms of COVID-19, other people in the household do not need to self- isolate at home with them 	the child can continue to attend school (unless any member of the household develops symptoms of COVID-19)
we/my child has travelled and has to self-isolate as a period of quarantine	 Do not take unauthorised leave in term time Consider requirements and FCO advice when booking travel 	the quarantine period of 14 days has been completed and you/your child has not developed any symptoms

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we have received medical advice that my child must resume shielding	 Returning from a destination where quarantine is needed: Agree an earliest date for possible return (min. 14 days) Self-isolate the whole household Do not come into school Contact school to inform us Shield until you are informed that restrictions are lifted and shielding is paused again 	restrictions have been lifted and your child can return to school again
my child's bubble (whole school) is closed due to a positive case of COVID-19 in school	 Do not come into school Your child will need to self-isolate for 14 days At home, support your child with remote education provided by the school Please note – advice at present is that siblings in other bubbles do not need to self-isolate unless a member of the household develops symptoms 	school informs you that the bubble will be re-opened
a sibling's bubble (at a different school) is closed due to a positive case of COVID-19 in their school	 The sibling must self-isolate for 14 days or until their bubble re-opens The sibling attending CRPS can continue to attend school as long as nobody in the household has symptoms of COVID-19 	sibling at CRPS can continue to attend school UNLESS anybody in the household develops symptoms of COVID-19
I am unable to get a test for a member of my household who has symptoms of COVID-19	 If you are not able to get a test in the first 5 days of having symptoms, the symptomatic person must self-isolate for 10 days The rest of the household must self-isolate for 14 days. Anyone in your support bubble must also self-isolate. 	the child has completed 10 days of isolation if they were symptomatic OR 14 days if another member of the household was symptomatic. The child needs to be well before returning to school

There is a symptom-checker on our website, as well as details of what to do if you suspect your child or anybody in your household has contracted Covid-19.
