ROUTINE FOR DROP-OFF/PICK-UP:

Some reminders:

- Please consider wearing a face covering at drop-off and pickup (unless exempt).
- Make sure you keep your physical distance from others.
- If you have children at New Beginnings, as well as Coombe Road Primary, please use the family drop-off at the middle Coombe Road gate (if this is helpful).
- Please be on time for drop-off and pick-up as it increases risk to all children and staff if they have to be collected/dropped off at the main entrance (out of their usual bubble).
- If you are late, please respect the office space and wait until the area is clear to avoid over-crowding.
- If you need to talk to the teacher and they are directing children in/out of the school, please wait in a safe space (or telephone).



Thank you for your understanding and support in helping us to prevent school closure and keep everybody in our Coombe Road family safe.

PARKING:

Parking restrictions are being brought into the area next week. These do not affect drop-off and pickup, but they will affect parking between 11-12. If you need to collect your child in this hour, please be aware of these restrictions.

POSITIVE TESTS:

If your child receives a positive test at the weekend/out of school hours, please email admin@coomberoad.brighton-hove.sch.uk or message us through our Facebook page (Coombe Road PTA & Community). Please mark the message as "URGENT: COVID"

CHRISTMAS:

The Christmas period will feel very different this year but we will make it as jolly as we can for our children here at Coombe Road Primary.

There are restrictions around singing which we will follow to ensure each class performs their own song (restrictions do not allow the children to sing as a whole school). We are incredibly sad that you will not be able to come into the school to watch our children perform this year – but these will be filmed for you to enjoy via our website. We will be sending out a consent form for the filming via Ping - so please respond so that we are aware of which children have permission.

Christmas lunch will be on 16th December and children can wear a Christmas/winter jumper on this day. Please ensure you request the lunch choice via Ping.

Food packages and vouchers will be sent (to those who have requested one) via the children on Thursday, 17th December. There are a lot to give out so please be patient on this day as it may take us some time to get the children (and packages) safely to you at the end of the school day. Many, many thanks to Plant Stories Kitchen (Gems Wholesome Kitchen & 'Fu Fighters) for such a generous gift to our families.

We may be able to help by putting you in contact with other organisations – or we could help with a few toys? Please don't keep worries to yourself – we don't have a magic wand, and we don't have much, but will always try and do whatever we can for our children, who we care about greatly.

PARENT GOVERNOR VOTING PROCESS:

We have decided to use PING as our method for voting in the parent governor election. This means that your vote will not be 100% anonymous – however, only Sheila Walker (Clerk to Governors) will have access to the information as the data is counted automatically. Information will not be shared with anyone else, nor will this information be kept, or referred to, in the future. Once votes are counted this information will be deleted, after the statutory period expires (6 months), from the system.

Due to Covid-19 restrictions we will not be able to accept paper voting slips, however you can contact Sheila Walker at the school, who can then add your votes on your behalf.

The information on the 4 parent/carer governor nominees will be sent out via PING on Friday 20th November and parents and carers will have 2 weeks to vote for their preferred 3 candidates.

The votes will be counted on Friday 4th December at 10am.

TIER 2:

Brighton & hove has been placed in Tier 2. Please continue to follow the guidance below:

- keep up physical distancing especially in places where people cluster like bus stops, crossings, doorways and queues;
- wash hands regularly or use hand gel when that is not possible;
- wear face coverings if you able to and be considerate of those who can't;
- do not mix with other households indoors;
- only make essential journeys;
- use the NHS Test and Trace app if you have a smart phone or give contact details when asked;
- self-isolate if you have symptoms or are waiting for a test along with everyone you live with (you must self-isolate if a member of your household has symptoms or tests positive, even if you have no symptoms yourself);
- send the school any advice you have received from NHS Track & Trace, 111 or Public Health England so that we can ensure children complete the correct isolation period;
- send the school any information regarding communication following direct contact with a positive person (you should receive this through NHS Track & Trace or Public Health England).

WE ALL NEED TO MAKE EXTRA EFFORTS OR RISK SCHOOL CLOSURE

ABSENCE FROM SCHOOL:

Please call us if your child is unable to attend school. It is really important that you also give us the reason for the absence. If the cause of absence is unreasonable, this will be unauthorised and you may be at risk of a Fixed Penalty Notice (issued by Brighton & Hove Council).

If your child has any of the following symptoms (or any member of your household), the household must self-isolate for 14 days (I have again attached the guidance for your information):

- High temperature/fever (38°C or more)
- Persistent, new cough
- Loss of taste
- Loss of smell

There is a symptom-checker on our website, as well as details of what to do if you suspect your child or anybody in your household has contracted Covid-19.
