Coronavirus restrictions remain in place across the country, including for people who have been vaccinated. In England:

- You can meet indoors in a group of up to 6 people or a group of any size from 2 households
- You can meet outside in a group of up to 30 people
- Work from home if you can and travel safely
- If you have symptoms get a test and stay at home

LFD testing is available to adults living in a household with school-aged children. The tests are for adults only and should not be used on children. ATTENDANCE

As restrictions ease, we have been advised to follow pre-Covid guidance in regards to attendance and to issue FPNs (Fixed Penalty Notices) for the following:

- Unauthorised holidays in term-time.
- Persistent late arrivals after the register has closed.
- Poor attendance (3 or more days in a term where the absence has not been accounted for).

96% attendance throughout the year is considered good. Anything below this figure is worrying (unless there are exceptional circumstances).


MEAL VOUCHERS OVER HALF TERM
